Kevin Colbert and his wife, Janis, have 3 children; Kacie, Jennifer and Daniel and 4 grandchildren; Avery, Colby, Brock and Emma.

After graduating from North Catholic, he enrolled at the Community College of Allegheny County for two years. He transferred to Robert Morris University and earned a bachelor's degree.


During his studies, he served as a sports information director. He later became a graduate assistant basketball coach and head baseball coach.

Kevin's early career included roles with Ohio Wesleyan University, BLESTO scouting, the Miami Dolphins, and the Detroit Lions. On February 15, 2000, he joined the Pittsburgh Steelers as Director of Football Operations. Kevin's title was changed to General Manager in 2011. Over the past 19 years, his efforts have helped guide the Steelers to 2 Super Bowls, 3 AFC Championships, 9 division titles, and 12 playoff berths.

He credits his position and his success to many mentors, including: Ron Hughes (high school coach), Matt Furjanic Jr. (Robert Morris University Basketball), Jack Butler (BLESTO scouting), Don Shula & Chuck Connor (Miami Dolphins), Wayne Fontes & Bobby Ross (Detroit Lions) and Dan Rooney & Art Rooney II (Pittsburgh Steelers).

Kevin was fortunate to work around professionals like Miami Dolphins Head Coach Don Shula who attended mass every day and Steelers Owner, the late Dan Rooney, who, apart from attending mass daily, had relationships with Cardinals, Bishops and priests. Mr. Rooney's values carried over to the Steelers organization where he took time and care to personally check in on staff and players. This tradition preceded him with Art Rooney, Sr. and continues today with Art Rooney II.

In the community, Kevin tries to apply the blessings he receives from his occupation to help others. As a member of the North Catholic Board of Directors, he supported the School's relocation to Cranberry and its enrollment growth to nearly 600 students annually. He also serves on the Board of Trustees of Robert Morris University and is an advisory member of the HM3 Partners Independence Fund.















Jim Krenn rose the ranks of stand-up comedians to become a renowned Pittsburgh entertainer & well-known host of the city's top-rated morning show on 102.5 WDVE (for 24 years!). He has been voted "Top Entertainer" and "Favorite Radio Personality" 14 times by Pittsburgh Magazine.

Krenn appears on TV frequently and has performed with the likes of Jay Leno,

Howie Mandel, Dennis Miller, Jerry Seinfeld, Richard Lewis, Gilbert Gottfried, Tim Allen and many other well-known celebrities.

Krenn's act features impressions, characters and anecdotes including his signature take on local Pittsburgh personalities, making him the area's most popular and beloved performer.
